

# 7th Annual Western Invitational Chess Camp

## July 11-15, 2010

- Invitational Camp: Players grouped by USCF rating (adults are welcome!): Expected rating breakdowns per group (varies from year to year).  
Group 1: 2000+                      Group 3: 1600-1800  
Group 2: 1800-2000                Group 4: 1600/below  
**\*minimum rating of 1500** to attend.
- Relevant Dates:            Camp: July 11-15, 2010 (Sunday thru Thursday)  
Ye Olde Pueblo Open: Adult Tournament, July 16-18  
Arrival: July 10 if flying, otherwise July 11th in morning);  
Departure date: July 19 if playing tournament, July 16 otherwise.
- Past Instructors:            GM's Greg Kaidanov, Yuri Shulman, Alex Onischuk, Larry Christiansen, Alex Yermolinsky, Alejandro Ramirez; IM Master Levon Altounian, FM Robby Adamson; This year's camp will have at least 2 and probably 3 GM's. Each GM works with ALL groups.
- How to Register:            Cost is \$700.00 per player. To reserve space send \$250.00 non-refundable deposit by May 31 to Tucson Chess, LLC, 6230 N. Calle Del Halcon, Tucson, AZ 85718, and email to Robby Adamson (see below). Balance of fee (\$450.00), permission form must be submitted prior to camp. Above fee includes lodging if done in advance. **\$50 discount to previous attendees.**
- Lodging:                        Students are housed at homes of local scholastic camp participants during camp and adult tournament at no charge if done in advance and based on availability. Younger players may want their parents to accompany them. Several hotels are nearby.
- Meals:                            Students pay for lunch, a few dinners. (\$25/day max + incidentals).
- Typical Schedule:            Class 9:00 am to 12:00 pm; lunch break 12 to 1 pm; Class 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm (includes G/35 game + review by instructor)
- Special Activities:            Simul, Blitz Tournament, Evening parties, Ping Pong, One on One Evaluation with Instructors.
